Our mission is to provide access to decent, safe, and affordable housing opportunities for low income Native Americans and Alaska Natives within the Tribe's federally-designated service area and Coquille Tribal members of all income levels nationwide.

The Coquille Indian Housing Authority's mission is to plan, build, provide, maintain, modernize, and rehabilitate decent, safe, sanitary housing and secure residential community facilities for Coquille Tribal members and other Native American within the Service Area of the Coquille Indian Tribe.

2011

Our mission is to work towards the goal of ensuring that eligible low-income Coquille Tribal members and other Native Americans living in the Coquille Tribe's five-county service area have access to safe, affordable, sanitary housing and to promote homeownership opportunities for Coquille Tribal members and other Native Americans of all income levels.

2003

To plan, build, provide, and maintain decent, safe, sanitary housing and residential community facilities for Coquille Tribal Members and other Native Americans within the Service Area of the Coquille Indian Tribe.

2002

Our mission is to plan, build and operate decent homes, providing an attractive community, for deserving families, utilizing our professional crews and staff, and improving family life and living conditions, and increasing self-sufficiency for Tribal members, all Native Americans and others in need of affordable housing within our arms reach.
