During the month, **5** applications were completed.

Applicants

- 4 Coquille: 2 applied for LR and MHAP, 1 eligible for both, 1 eligible for MHAP and ineligible for LR due to past habits and practices. 1 applied for MHAP, conditionally eligible due to utilities and past debt to CIHA. 1 applied for OSA, eligible.
- 1 Non-Coquille: Applied for LR and MHAP; filed inactive due to lack of contact.

Applicants found conditionally eligible due to outstanding utilities or amounts owed to landlords are provided guidance on becoming fully eligible. When documentation is received showing that a repayment agreement is in place or a balance has been cleared, the applicant is placed on the waiting list.
