A group of us went to Coquille Tribal member and spouse residents providing them with information taken from My Tribe about the health and wellness center. There was some good discussion and sadly the majority of residents had no idea this was happening. I, as well as others were unaware that the decision to build on the reservation has already been decided regardless of the opinions of the residents.

I welcome this upcoming presentation on the 30th March and this should also have happened years ago when this project was in the first planning stage.

Here is a petition with 35 signatures of people who have concerns about increased person and traffic safety, having strangers within the community and loss of residential community due to a public business in Kilkich.

I was asked to make it clear that some people were against the health and wellness center but didn't feel comfortable about signing it due to being related to, or working for people involved with the project.

I understand we can't expect you, the CIHA board to represent us but we would appreciate you writing to all Tribal Council members to let them know that at least these people are not in favor of our community being opened up to the public.


