- **3 Coquille:** 1 applied for LR and MHAP; conditionally eligible due to outstanding utilities. 1 applied for MHAP; eligible. 1 applied for OSA; eligible.
- **5 Non-Coquille:** 5 applied for LR and MHAP; 1 eligible for both, 3 conditionally eligible due to outstanding utilities, and 1 filed inactive due to lack of contact.

Applicants found conditionally eligible due to outstanding utilities or amounts owed to landlords are provided guidance on becoming fully eligible. When documentation is received showing that a repayment agreement is in place or a balance has been cleared, the applicant is placed on the waiting list.
