The colours: red and black, represent the fallen men and women within the fire service; blue, yellow and white represent the SRPMIC flag; blue also represents the Salt River and yellow also represents the willow baskets which are highly important to the community and their cultural traditions."

I know there's a lot of Celtic heritage among the Coquilles - maybe they might want to register their own tart too!
