During the month, 8 applications were completed.

Applicants

- 6 Coquille: 1 applied for LR and I-MHAP; eligible for I-MHAP, ineligible for LR due to past habits and practices. 4 applied for I-MHAP; eligible. 1 applied for O-MHAP; filed inactive due to lack of contact.
- 2 Non-Coquille: 2 applied for LR and MHAP; 1 conditionally eligible for MHAP due to outstanding utilities, ineligible for LR due to past habits and practices, and 1 filed inactive due to lack of contact.

Applicants found conditionally eligible due to outstanding utilities or amounts owed to landlords are provided guidance on becoming fully eligible. When documentation is received showing that a repayment agreement is in place or a balance has been cleared, the applicant is placed on the waiting list.
