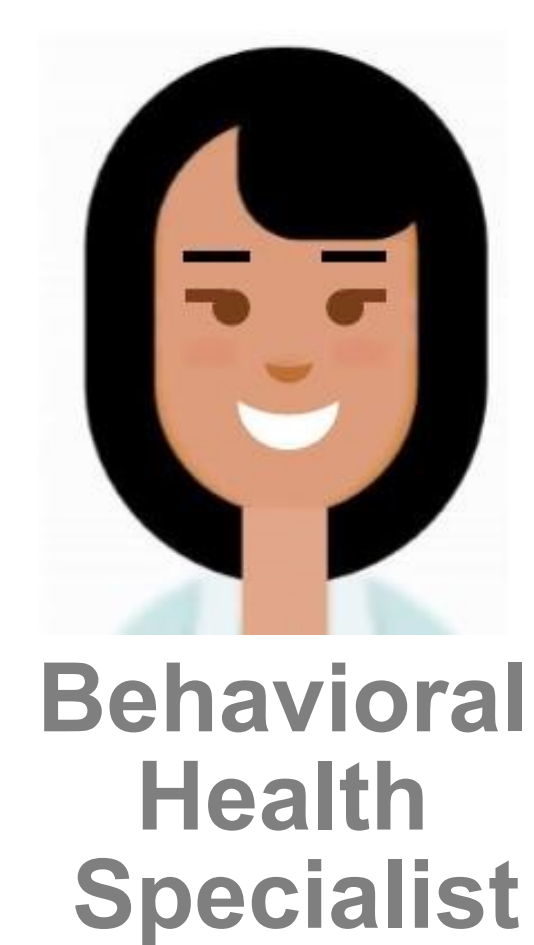

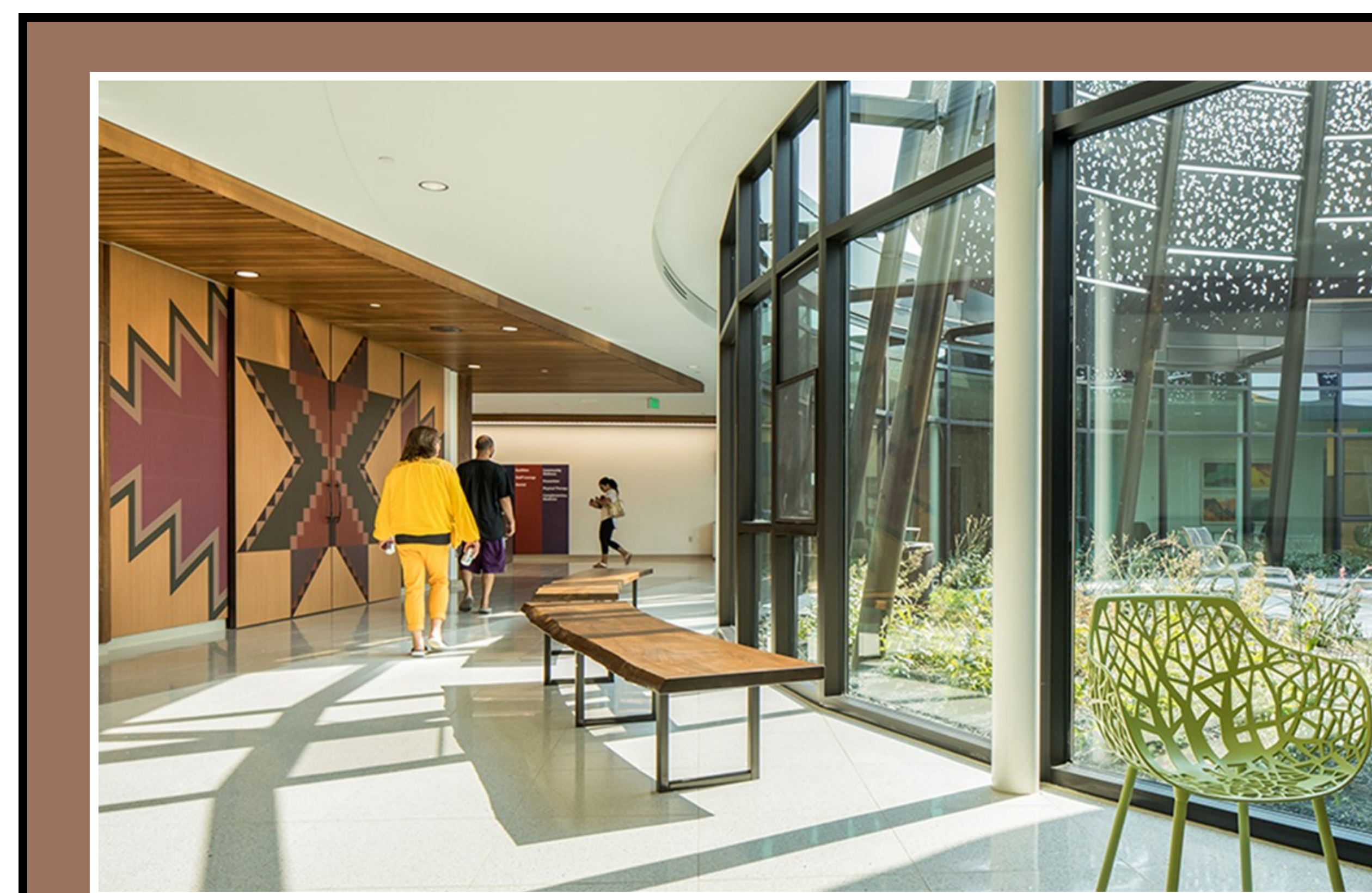
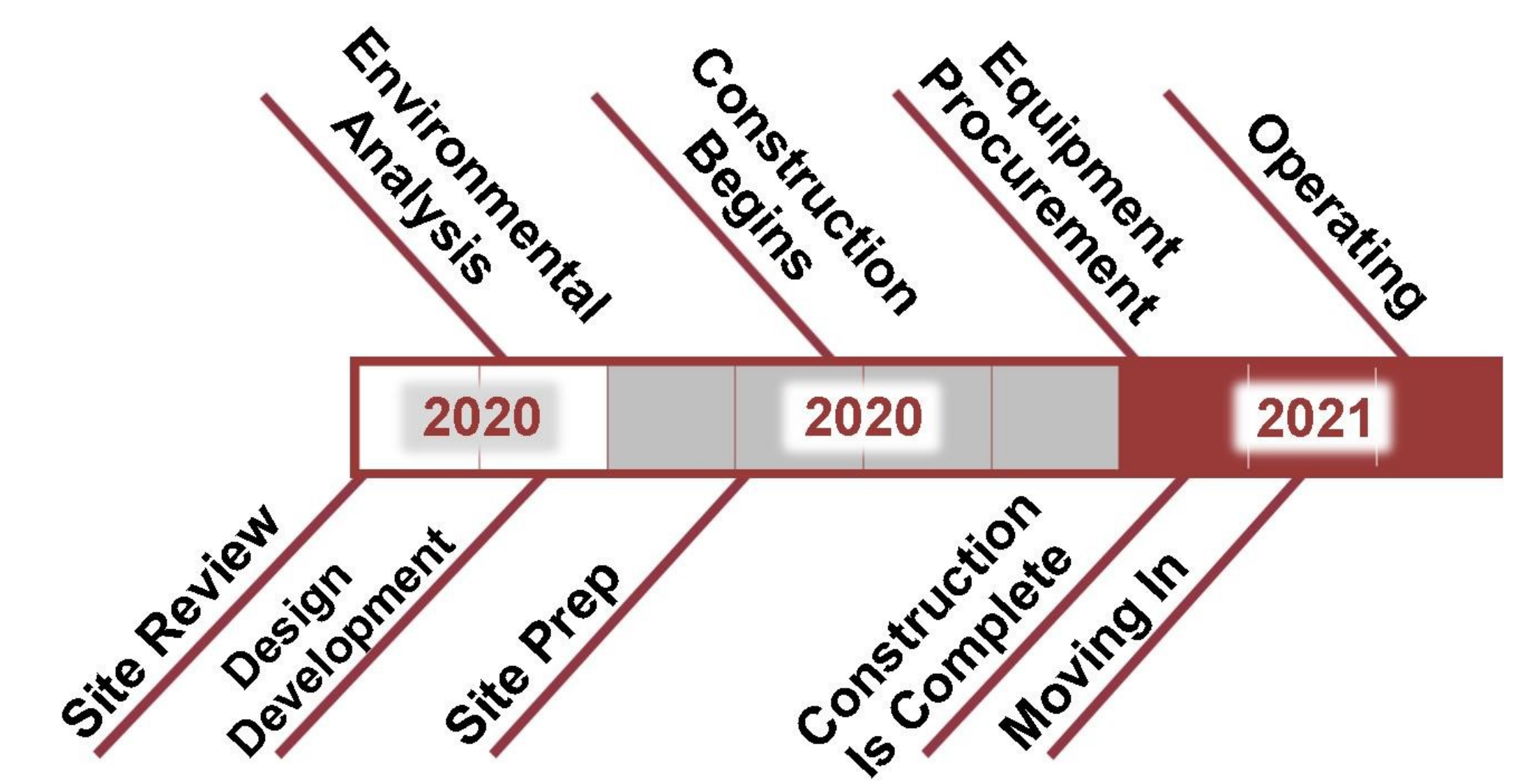
Project Basics
