**Calls to Service**

Coquille Indian Tribe Police Department (CITPD) and Coos County Sherriff's Office (CCSO) Combined

- 267 total, averaging 25 per month
  - 31 (11%) on Saturday/Sunday
  - 238 (89%) on Monday-Friday

CITPD

- 204 total, averaging 19 per month
  - Hours
    - 124 (61%) between 6 am and 2 pm
    - 71 (35%) between 2 pm and 10 pm
    - 9 (4%) between 10 pm and 6 am
  - Days
    - 20 (10%) on Saturday/Sunday
    - 186 (90%) on Monday-Friday
  - Location
    - 82 (40%) on Kilkich
    - 20 (10%) at other Tribal properties
    - 102 (50%) at non-Tribal properties

CCSO

- 63 total, averaging 6 per month
  - Days
    - 11 (17%) on Saturday/Sunday
    - 52 (83%) on Monday-Friday

## Other Actions

### CITPD and CCSO Combined

- 1,299 security checks, averaging 118 per month
- 19 general assistance actions
- 12 community engagement actions

### Coquille Indian Tribe Police

- 774 security checks, averaging 70 checks per month
  - Hours
    - 386 (50%) between 6 am and 2 pm
    - 382 (49%) between 2 pm and 10 pm
    - 6 (1%) between 10 pm and 6 am (all between 10 pm and 11 pm)
  - Location
    - 422 (55%) on Kilkich
    - 245 (32%) at other Tribal properties
    - 107 (13%) at non-Tribal properties (entirely traffic stops)
- 13 General Assistance
  - One at 3 am
  - 12 between 8 am and 4 pm
- 9 community engagement actions
  - All between 7 am and 5 pm

### CCSO

- 525 security checks, averaging 48 checks per month
- 28 K-9 trainings
- 6 general assistance actions
- 3 community engagement actions
