Are you behind on rent or utilities due to COVID-19? Are you experiencing financial hardship due to housing-related costs? If so, CIHA may be able to help you.

CIHA has received a grant from the U.S. Treasury to help Indian families remain or become stably housed during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Treasury funds are available to Coquille Tribal members nationwide and other Native Americans within CIHA's five-county service area - Coos, Curry, Douglas, Jackson, and Lane county.

The Treasury money can assist with:

- * Current and past due rent
- * Current and past due utilities
- * Rental deposits
- * Temporary or emergency shelter
- * Relocation costs
- * Other housing-related expenses

Per CIHA's Common Scheme Restriction Policy,

"All parking, other than in the driveway or garage, must be on the side of the street where the streetlights are and must NOT exceed 24 hours."

In addition, "No tent structure, camper, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, trail bike, snowmobile, boat, trailer, motor coach, or mobile home, or any structure of any kind shall be parked, placed, erected, or used upon the property."



Parking violation letters will be mailed out in May 2021.

If you receive a non-compliance letter, it will count against your December holiday credit.
