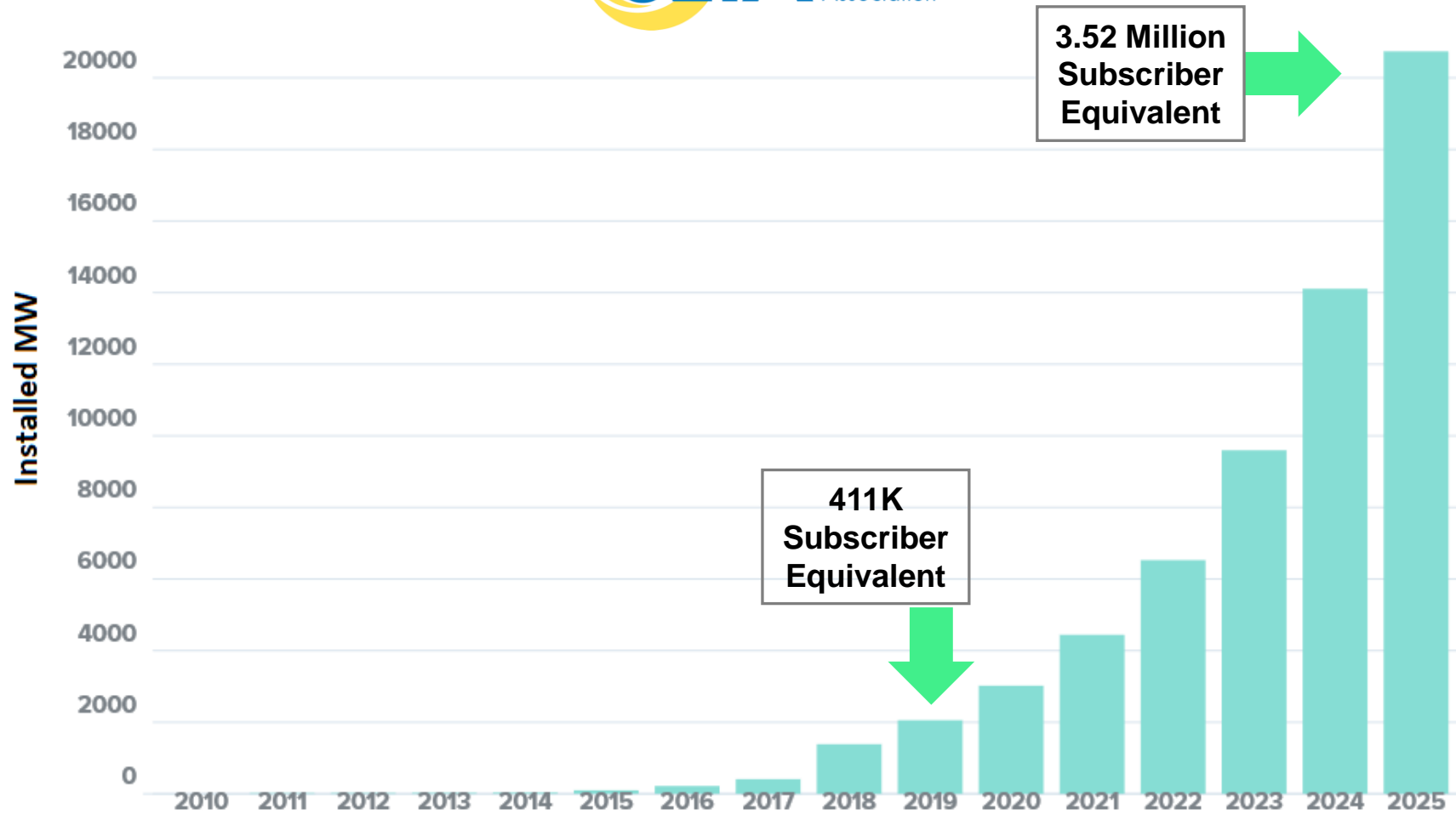
## Community Solar Farm
