LEGISLATIVE ALERT

Congress Passes Full Year FY22 Funding, Tribal Housing Jumps 21%

Yesterday, March 10, Congress passed the full year funding for FY 2022. The bill includes a 21% increase for funding to Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) programs. It increases the formula-funded Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) to \$772 million for tribes, which is the first substantial gain to the base formula grant program in decades.



The chart below shows the amounts Congress approved for FY 2022. In addition to the increase to the formula IHBG program, Congress also increased the **competitive IHBG funding to \$150 million**. In total, the funding bill included \$1 billion in dedicated funding for tribal housing programs from the <u>Department of Housing and Urban Development</u> (HUD).
