#### Call to Order

#### Old Business

- Emergency Preparedness Lon Matheny shared this in the chat: Emergency management has been moved under Community Services under the supervision of Jessica Hamner. Fauna has allowed me to work with them as boots on the ground in an effort to support Kilkich emergency preparedness. Lon also told the Board that he has been acquiring survival supplies with funds from a grant with the intent of encouraging residents to learn more about how to self-rescue and not become a victim of a natural disaster. Brady mentioned that people will need to know what's available and be trained in equipment use as well as how to manage people in panic or a disaster situation. Lon mentioned he is looking for ham radio operators or residents/community members who are willing to learn how to become ham radio operators and is trying to clear/level an area of land near the plankhouse to be used as a helicopter landing pad. The Board has asked Lon to talk to us next month about any updates.
- Kilkich Forest Nothing new, but this will be kept on the agenda. Brady suggested those concerned about the forest should let Tribal Council know since the 5-year plan for the forest is currently being reviewed.
