Housing help — Tribal housing programs serve hundreds of low-income Tribal families.

Current services:

- Affordable rental and homebuyer housing at Kilkich
- Support for the Kilkich Residents Association, Tribal Elders, Tribal Police Department, and Southcoast Interagency Narcotics Team
- Tenant-based rental assistance, nationwide
- Emergency assistance with rent, utilities, temporary housing, deposits, and similar costs, nationwide
- Emergency assistance with mortgage, utilities, back taxes, home repairs, and similar costs, nationwide

Coming soon:

- 2023
 - Rehabilitation of three low-income rental units to accessible design standards at Kilkich
 - New playground surfacing at Kilkich
 - Solar power to reduce CIHA operating costs
 - A First-Time Homebuyer Assistance Program for low-income Tribal homebuyers in Oregon
- 2024
 - Construction of five new low-income rental units to accessible design standards at Kilkich
 - Ductless heat pumps for multi-family units at Kilkich
 - Financial support to expand homeless services in Coos County, Oregon
