Subject: Biden signs H.R. 4366 into law



FY2024 Appropriations Package Passes in Senate, Signed by Pres. Biden



The [National American Indian Housing Council \(NAIHC\)](#) is pleased to announce the passage of [H.R.4366 - Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024](#) in the Senate, and the subsequent [authorization](#) of this spending package by President Biden. The Senate passed the Act [just hours before the midnight deadline on Friday, March 8th](#), with a ye/nay vote of 75-22, respectively. The package includes the [Military Construction-VA measure](#), [Agriculture](#), [Commerce-Justice-Science](#), [Energy-Water](#), [Interior-Environment](#), and [Transportation-HUD](#) bills.

As we broadcast in last week's update, the T-HUD Bill includes ***a significant amount of funding appropriated to American Indian and Native Hawaiian housing programs.***

The [Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies Fiscal Year 2024 Appropriations Bill](#) contains promising increases in the amount of federal funding available for Native housing development.

For Native American Programs through HUD, the bill contains the following:

Tribal HUD-VASH	\$7.5 million
Title I of NAHASDA	\$1.34 billion
Indian Housing Block Grants (IHBGs)	\$1.11 billion
Competitive Grants	\$150 million
Title VI Loans	\$1 million
Indian Community Development Block Grants (ICBGs)	\$75 million
Imminent threats to health and safety (within ICBGs)	\$5 million
Training and Technical Assistance	\$7 million
National Organization Funding (per Sec.703 of NAHASDA)	\$2 million
Loans Under Section 184	\$1.5 million

For the Native Hawaiian Program, the bill contains the following:

Native Hawaiian Block Grant Program	\$22.3 million
Training and Technical Assistance	\$1 million
Total loan principal under Section 184	\$28 million
