Common Scheme Restrictions for Members of the Kilkich Community

The purpose of the Kilkich community Common Scheme Restrictions is to enhance the use, safety, sanitation, and beauty of the Kilkich community.

Below is a reminder of two of the common scheme restrictions to be aware of. For a complete list of the Kilkich Common Scheme Restrictions, please contact the CIHA office at (541) 888-6501.

- All parking, other than in the driveway or garage, must be on the side of the street where the streetlights are and must not exceed 24 hours.
- No tent structure, camper, recreational vehicle, motorcycle, trail bike, snowmobile, boat, trailer, motor coach or mobile home, or any structure of any kind shall be parked, placed, erected, or used upon the property. Certain structures may be placed upon the property with the permission of CIHA.
